He was subsequently arrested and tried. He was crucified at Calvary on Good Friday, outside the gates of Jerusalem. He was buried the same day, and arose three days later, on Easter Sunday. All of this is done by our Lord for forgiveness of our sins, and for life everlasting with Him. God so loved us, that He sent His only begotten Son to die for us, so that our sins maybe forgiven. Holy Saturday, The night the Church keeps vigil waiting for the Resurrection of the Lord.

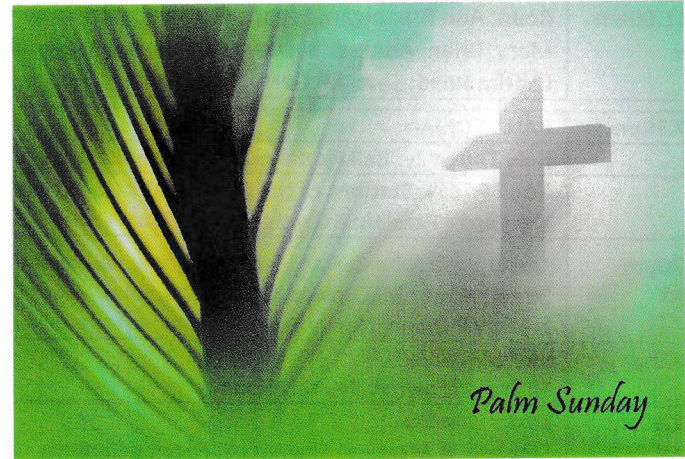

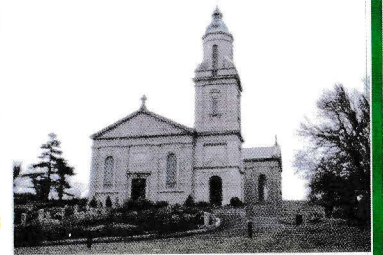

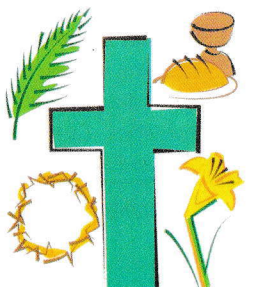
