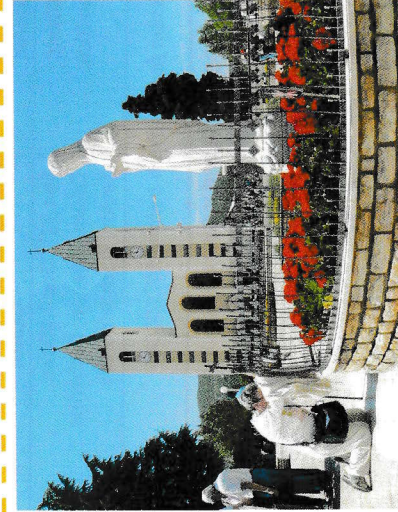

THE MEANING OF THE ADVENT WREATH

The Advent wreath is a Christian tradition that symbolises the passage of the four weeks of Advent. It is a circular candle holder that typically holds five candles. During the season of Advent one candle on the wreath is lit each Sunday until all the candles, including the fifth candle, are lit on Christmas Day. Each candle represents an aspect of the spiritual preparation for the celebration of the birth of Our Lord Jesus Christ.

Most Advent wreaths use three colours of candles-purple, pink and white. However, some may use blue instead of the purple.

1st candle - (purple): THE PROPHECY CANDLE or CANDLE OF HOPE

We can hope because God is faithful and will keep the promises made to us. Our hope comes from God.

2nd candle - (purple): THE BETHLEHEM CANDLE or THE CANDLE OF PREPARATION

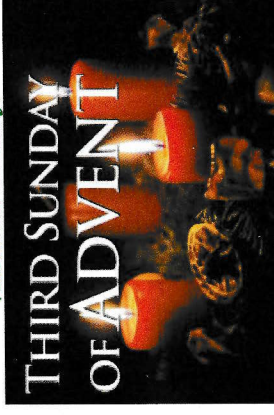
God kept his promise of a Saviour who would be born in Bethlehem. Preparation means to get ready to welcome God.

3rd candle - (pink): THE SHEPHERD CANDLE or THE CANDLE OF JOY

The angels sang a message of JOY. This third Sunday of Advent is also known as "Gaudete Sunday" which means rejoice.

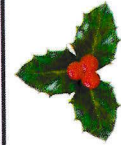
