POPE FRANCIS PAPAL ITINERARY

Pope Francis will touch down at Dublin Airport at 10:30am on Saturday, August 25th. He will be greeted by clergy and representatives of the Government. First up, a trip to Aras an Uachtaráin to meet President Michael D Higgins and his wife Sabina. There will be a welcome ceremony at the main gate to the Aras, beside the Phoenix Monument.

On to Dublin Castle he will meet the Taoiseach as well as church leaders, the Council of State, Government MEPs, Northern Ireland political leaders and some members of the judiciary. This will be where the first of his three planned speeches during the two-day trip will be given. Then, the first major event of the trip - the Pope will give an address to the Festival of Families at Croke Park.

On Sunday, Pope Francis will fly from Dublin to Knock where he will lead the Angelus. Then fly back to Dublin and on to the Phoenix Park, where he will be the chief celebrant in a special 3pm Mass at the site of the Papal Cross. Afterwards, the Pope will meet the Irish Bishops at the Convent of the Dominican Sisters in Cabra, before flying back to Rome. 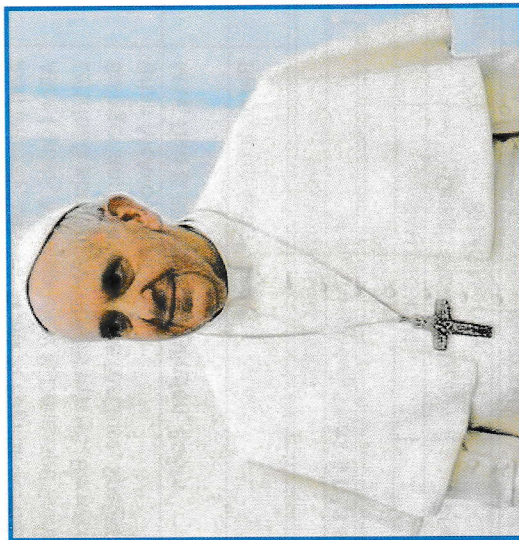
