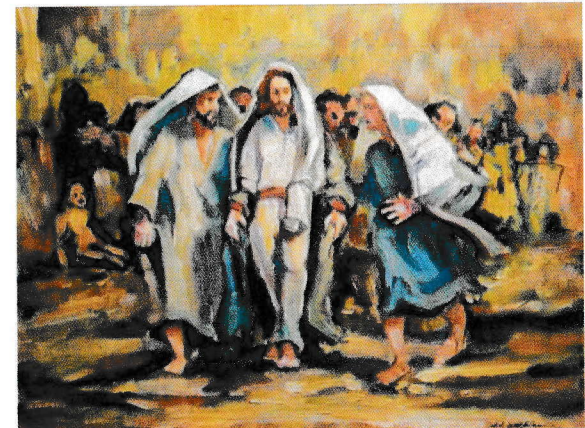
The Annual Mary Doyle Knock Trip

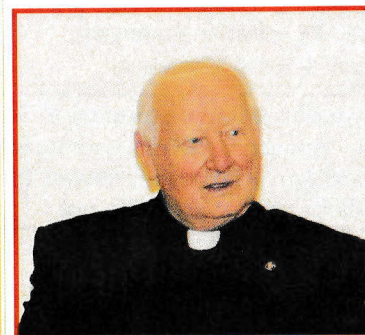
