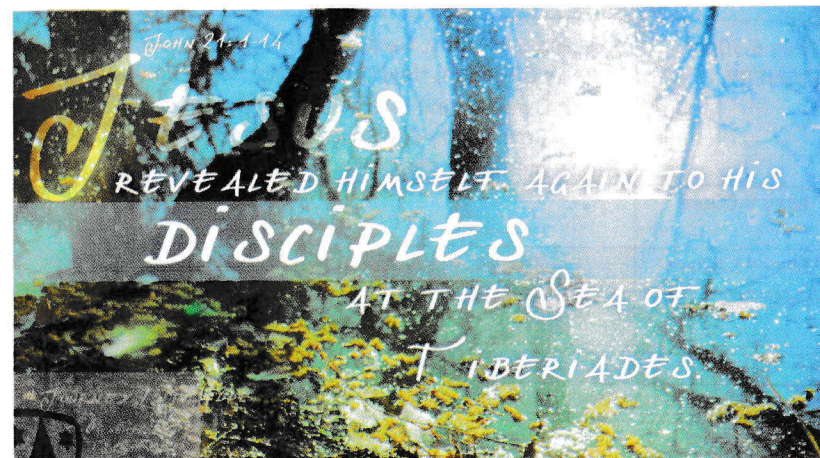
Pope Francis on Thursday released a video message accompanying his prayer intention for May, which this month is for the Church in Africa.

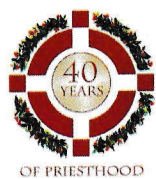
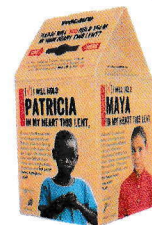
