

Hospital Chaplaincy in the Southern Trust in These Days

While chaplains are not permitted to do routine hospital visits at the moment, they are still available for emergency or urgent visits. To call a chaplain at any time, just ring the relevant hospital and ask for the chaplain on call. In addition, if you or a family member are in hospital, or indeed if you work in the hospital, and you would like to chat with a chaplain, there is a chaplaincy phone service available daily:

How to make a Spiritual Communion:

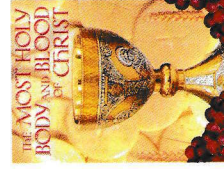
- Start with the Sign of the Cross.

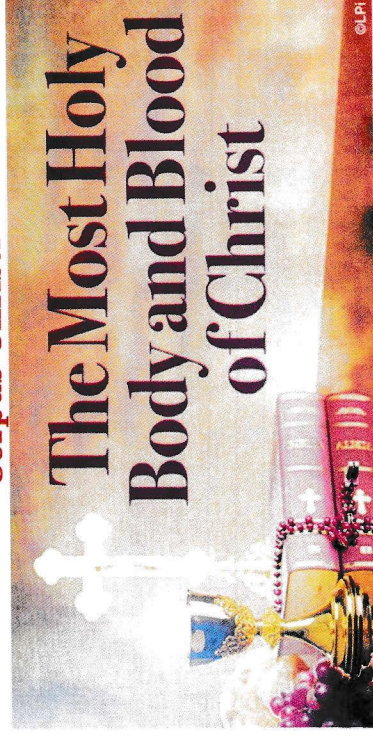
