

RETURNING TO MASS IN CLONDUFF

Public Mass will resume this weekend of 18th/19th July. There will be Mass in Ballymaghery on Saturday 18th July at 6pm and again in Ballymaghery on Sunday 19th July at 11am.

However we would like to emphasise that the obligation to attend remains **SUSPENDED**. No one should feel under any obligation to attend public Mass at this time due to the ongoing health crisis. Mass will continue to be streamed via **WEBCAM** and we expect that this is how most people will continue to participate in Mass for the foreseeable future. It is **STRONGLY** recommended that those who are shielding, senior citizens and the vulnerable **SHOULD NOT** attend public Mass at this time. Anyone who is displaying any symptoms whatsoever **MUST NOT** attend public Mass.

For those who feel that they are in a position to return to Mass we ask that you take great care to protect yourself and others, adhering to social distancing of 2m and following the directions in the Church to ensure everyone's safety. The **NUMBER** of people who can attend Mass will be **LIMITED** in line with social distancing. Stewards will be in attendance to guide you through the new protocols. We respectfully ask for everyone's cooperation and to follow the instruction of the stewards in the Church.

Fr Byrne and the pastoral council are extremely grateful to those who have volunteered to assist with stewarding and extra cleaning duties. Without this help we would not have been able to return to public Mass at this time. Thank you all.

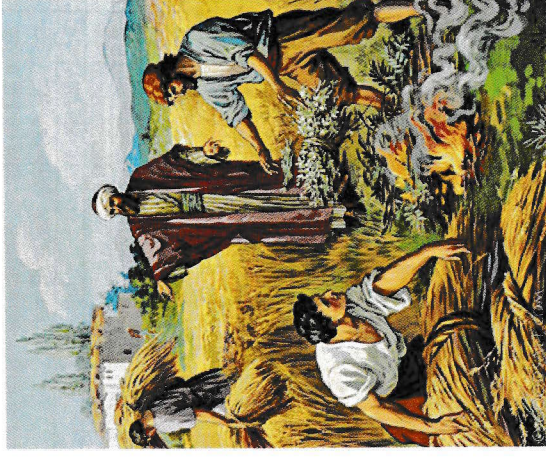

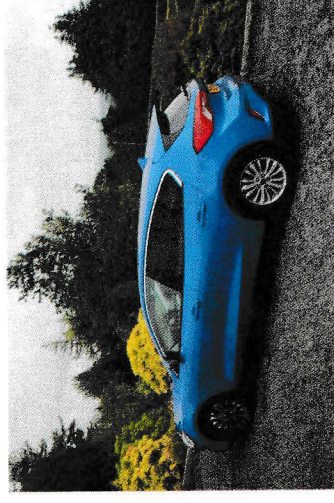
St John's Church, Ballymaghery and St Mary's Church, Cabra are now open daily.
