

Guidelines for attending Mass

- . Please enter church through main front door.
- . As you enter church please sanitise hands with the sanitisers provided.
- . Give your name and contact details to steward who is recording for contact tracing.
- . Please follow steward to your seat as the church will be filled from front to back as to avoid contact with others.
- . Communion will be distributed at the end of mass.
- . When coming to receive communion side aisles will receive first and you must sanitise your hands before receiving with the sanitisers at front of church. After receiving communion please exit the church through the side doors (Do not return to your seat)
- . COMMUNION MUST BE RECEIVED ON YOUR HAND.
- . Again stewards will direct you at this time.
- . These rules are in place to ensure the safety of you as an individual, our Priest and ministers of the Eucharist in these unprecedented times.
- . Thank you for your cooperation

RETURNING TO MASS IN CLONDUFF

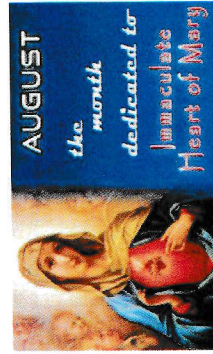
Public Mass will resume. There will be Mass in Ballymaghery on **Saturday at 6pm** and again in Ballymaghery on **Sunday at 11am.**
