They will now Reopen next weekend Saturday 12th Dec.

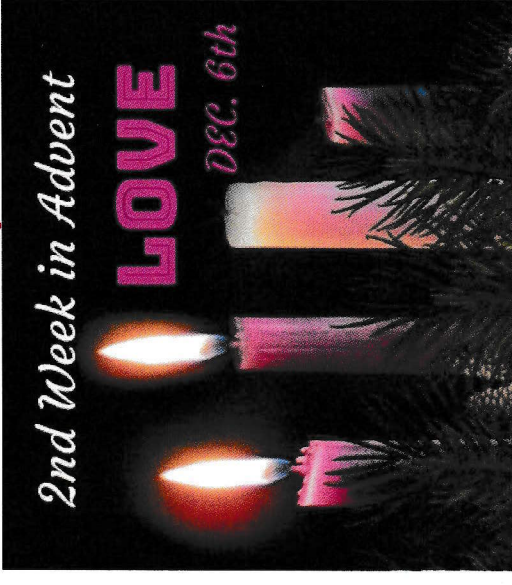
Places of worship will remain Open for Private Prayer only.
