We continue to strongly encourage participation, where possible, including in the ceremonies of Holy Week, by way of live-streaming.

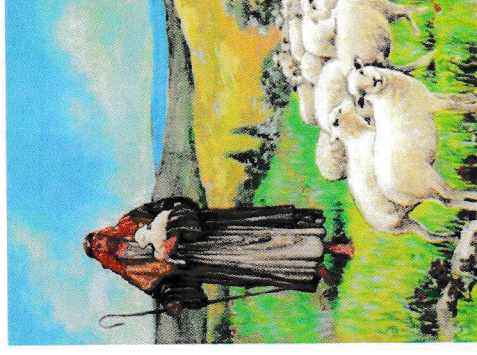

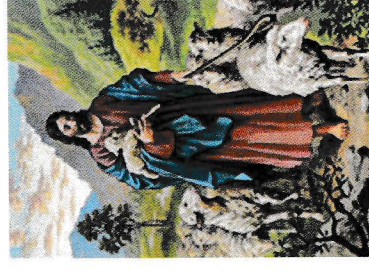
