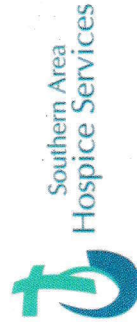


Synodal Church - Pastoral Message from Archbishop Eamon and Synodal Core Group

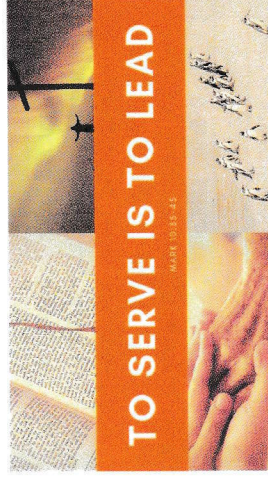
