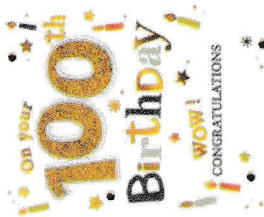
CHURCH DOOR COLLECTION

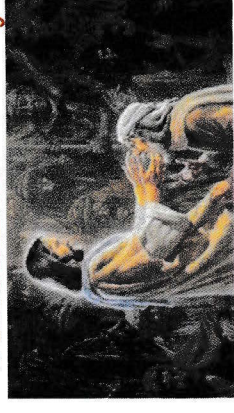
