Dromore Diocesan Pilgrimage to Knock

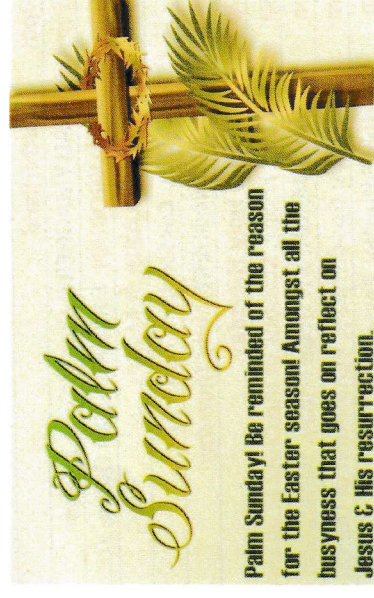
