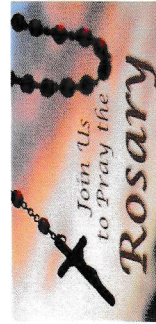

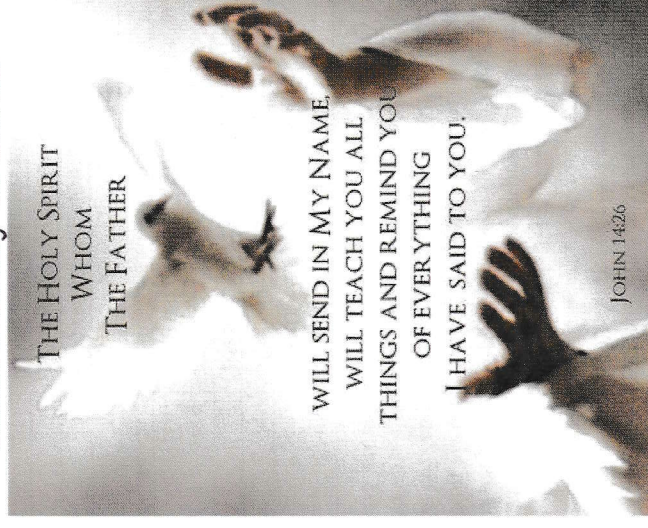


Adoration will take place every Tuesday evening 7.00pm to 8.00pm with the Rosary being recited at 7.45pm in Ballymaghery. All are welcome..
