2022 GUIDED TOURS OF NEWRY CATHEDRAL

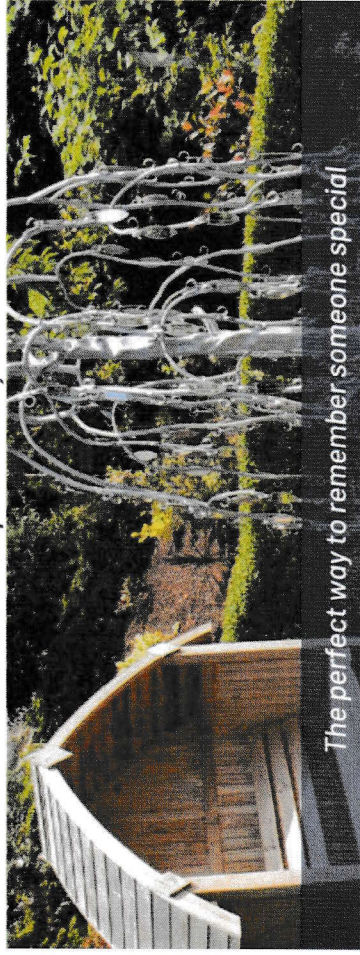
We are pleased to announce that, following the interruption caused by the pandemic, we will once again offer guided tours of the Cathedral on the following dates:

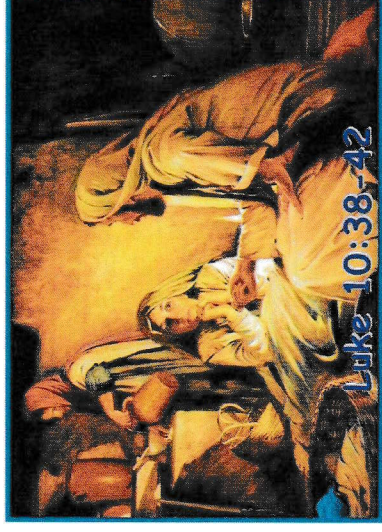
