ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

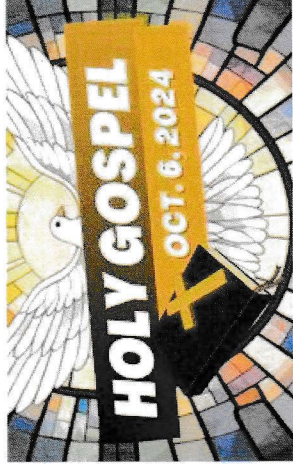
